Following are the details of the magazine:

**Theme-** Unfolding Potentials: A spectrum of Opportunities through the lens India, Europe and Latin America

**Focus areas**- Overview of Trilateral relations (India, Europe and Latin America), Sustainability, Defence, Education, Cultural, Diaspora, Language, Gastronomy, Tourism, Sports, Geopolitical, Economy, History and Technology

Entries- Articles, Short stories, Poems, Illustrations (Posters, Caricatures, Photographs)

Languages- English, Hindi, Spanish, French, Portuguese and any major European and Latin American languages

**Focus Group-** University students between the age group of 18-25













## Common guidelines for the submission are as follows:

- 1. Submissions are open to everyone (across the world).
- 2. One entry will be accepted per individual.
- 3. Entries must be related to the theme of 'Unfolding Potentials: A spectrum of Opportunities through the lens India, Europe and Latin America'.
- 4. The nature of the entries must be apolitical. No political reviews will be accepted.
- 5. Give the entry a suitable title.
- 6. The entry should be your original creation and not plagiarised.
- 7. The entry must be submitted in both PDF and Word format.
- 8. The size of the entry should not exceed 20-24 MB.
- 9. In case the entry is being submitted via Google Drive Link, please ensure the access is updated to edit all.
- 10. An acknowledge mail will be sent within 24-48 hours (post receiving the entry).
- 11. As the magazine has to accommodate many languages, we will not be able to publish all the entries hence submission does not imply selection.
- 12. **Deadline:** August 17, 2022 (12:00 Hours UTC)

# Specific Guidelines are as follows:

#### A. Article

- The word limit should be within 800-1000 words.
- Entrants must ensure factual accuracy of their submissions.
- Citations and references should be given at the end of the article.
- The referencing format has to be APA.
- Font- Times New Roman, Font Size- 12, Alignment- Justified and Title should be in Bold.
- The entry should be submitted in both PDF and Word document format.
- In case an image is attached with the story, please cite the source of the image.
- Mention of obscenity, vulgarness and political reviews are prohibited.

#### **B.** Short Stories

- The word limit should be within 450-500 words.
- The story can be both fictional or non-fictional.
- Font- Times New Roman, Font Size- 12, Alignment- Justified and Title should be in Bold.
- The entry should be submitted in both PDF and Word document format.
- In case an image is attached with the story, please cite the source of the image.
- Mention of obscenity, vulgarness and political reviews are prohibited.













### C. Poems

- The maximum limit of the poem is 4 prose.
- Font- Times New Roman, Font Size- 12, Alignment- Justified and Title should be in Bold.
- The entry should be submitted in both PDF and Word document format.
- In case an image is attached with the story, please cite the source of the image.
- Mention of obscenity, vulgarness and political reviews are prohibited.

# D. Illustrations (Posters, Caricatures, Photographs)

- The illustration should have an appropriate title.
- Mention of obscenity, vulgarness and political reviews are prohibited.
- The size of the file should not exceed more than 24 MB and in case the entry is being submitted via google drive link, kindly ensure the access is updated to edit all.
- The poster and caricature could be both digital or handmade. The handmade illustration should be comprehensible and legible. The illustration should ensure some relevance and interlinkage between a minimum of 2 regions and should have a caption as well. The word limit of the caption is 150 words.
- The photograph should ensure some relevance and interlinkage between a minimum of 2 regions and should have a caption as well. The word limit of the caption is 150 words.

### The format of mailing the entry is as follows:

- 3. Mail Body- Name of the person, Type & Title of the entry, Email ID, Age, Country & City, Profession (if student there should be a mention of the university & course), Email ID and gender (not compulsory).
- 4. Mention the type of attachment and any other relevant detail.

- Please inform us in case you want to ensure anonymity of your entry if selected.
- The selected entries will be informed via mail on August 19, 2022.
- The focus area must ensure involvement of a minimum of 2 regions and linkage with India.
